



Within these specialties, there is likely to be a comprehensive range of earnings, as both orthopaedics and cardiology include surgical sub-specialists who inclined to make significantly more than their generalist counterparts. This year the most under earners, starting from the last place are Paediatricians \$204,000, Endocrinologists \$206,000 and family physicians

Highest Earners Of 2019 (Value in USD)




Lowest Earners Of 2019(Value in USD)

Total healthcare spending in the U.S. is required to reach up to USD 4.8 trillion in 2021 from USD 2.6 trillion in 2010-accounting for nearly 20% of the Gross Domestic Product (GDP) by 2021.
